Positives

Email

- When in a Google Meet:
 - Always turn your camera and microphone off.
 - There will be times that a teacher will ask you to turn these things on, but until that happens, they will remain off.
 - Ask questions using the comment box on the right side of your screen. All of the questions will be answered before the Meet ends.
 - If you are asked to turn your microphone and camera on during a Google Meet, no costumes, pets, or other crazy things should be in our view. We just need to see and hear you!

Google Meets

- What should you expect for classwork and homework?
 - Most of your assignments will be given during class. When this happens, we will give you time to hang up from the Meet and work on the assignments. Remember, don't wait until that night because there could be other homework assignments given at the end of the day.
 - You don't want to get behind and end up with too much to do in one night.
 - All assignments are due the next morning by 8:00.
 - We will not assign late grades for the first three weeks of school. After that grace period, late assignments will be penalized 20%. If the assignment is two weeks beyond the original due date it will be recorded as a "1" in Renweb. This means the assignment cannot be made up.

Homework/Classwork

- End of the day: Our wrap-up times will change from day to day depending on several things. You will check your Google Calendar for Meets scheduled later in the afternoon.
