



# WRITTEN WORK EXPECTATIONS

# RELIGION:

- Almost all religion assignments will be in Schoology.
- When answering religion questions on workbook pages you can find answers in three places, the chapter, the end of the chapter questions, and the notes.
- We will read the chapters on Mondays and review the first part of the notes. This will help with the first workbook page.
- When answering questions on the workbook pages you will need to write good complete sentences on the short answer questions every time you complete these types of pages.
- If you get stuck on a question, remember to look in the 3 places.....chapter, chapter questions, and notes!
- We will be completing weekly Gospel reflections. These will not begin until we are back in the classroom.

# LANGUAGE ARTS:

- There are 4 sections in language arts: **literature**, **grammar**, **writing**, and **spelling**.
- When answering questions for **literature** you will be expected to write good, thorough complete sentences.
- **Grammar** will be in Schoology. You will move the worksheet to Notability and submit to Showbie. Most of these assignments will be answers only. It will be noted if a complete sentence is needed.
- While we are virtual, all writing will be in Schoology. Once we're back in the classroom you will need a composition book. I will let you know ahead of time! All **writing** assignments will need to be in complete sentences.
- **Spelling** packets will be uploaded every other week. You will move these to Notability then Showbie. We will have spelling tests every other week as well.

# **SOCIAL STUDIES:**

- Most social studies assignments will require answers only.
- I will tell you ahead of time if I want you to write your answers in complete sentences.
- There will be several places to look for social studies answers. All of these things will be in Schoology. The places to look will be in the textbook, work documents uploaded to Schoology, power points uploaded to schoology, videos uploaded to Schoology, and notes provided in Schoology.
- Social Studies overview: Geography, Early America, Establishment and settlement of 12 Original Colonies, Revolutionary War, Articles of Confederation, Constitution, Bill of Rights, Amendments

# MATH:

- We will go through the math textbook in order and cover most sections.
- Lesson begins promptly at start time.
- We will do guided practice work within each section and if we have time we will do the Let's Practice section and share answers.
- Your workbook pages will be assigned for each section and will be due the following morning at 8:00 a.m.
- The majority of your math assignments will start in Schoology, then be sent to Notability, and submitted to Showbie.
- **SHOW ALL WORK AT ALL TIMES!**
- IXL will be assigned most days and count as a homework grade.
- IXL should be completed to 80% OR 20 minutes.
- You will get a review before each quiz or test.
- The reviews are homework grades that count for 10 points but must be submitted.
- Do not work ahead while in our lesson. Please type all questions in the comments section of our Google Meet.
